St. Jude Catholic School Admission Policy

St. Jude Catholic School has an Admissions Policy that opens the school to families who desire an authentic Catholic education for their children, who are supportive of our mission, philosophy, and standards of education, and whose children meet our enrollment standards. St. Jude admits students of any sex, race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded to students in the school. We are a parish elementary school supported by tuition and the contribution of the members of the parish.

Age requirements: Children must be 3 years old by September 1st of the year they are entering to register for our 3 year old programs, and 4 years old by September 1st to apply for 4-year-old programs. Preschoolers must be potty-trained. Kindergarteners must be 5 years old by September 1st to enroll.
